


In 2012, Ghanaian growth outpaced each of Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa (the BRICS)

In 2012, Ghana's GDP growth of 8.2% outpaced each of the BRICS countries. China's growth rate was 7.8% whereas Brazil's growth was only 1.3%. Out of the 220 countries for which data was available, Ghana was 15th.



Ghana's per capita GDP of \$3300 is nearly at-par with India and services comprise nearly 50% of the total figure. The Economist forecasts that Ghana will remain one of the world's 10 fastest growing economies upto 2015, joining 6 other African countries on the list.
