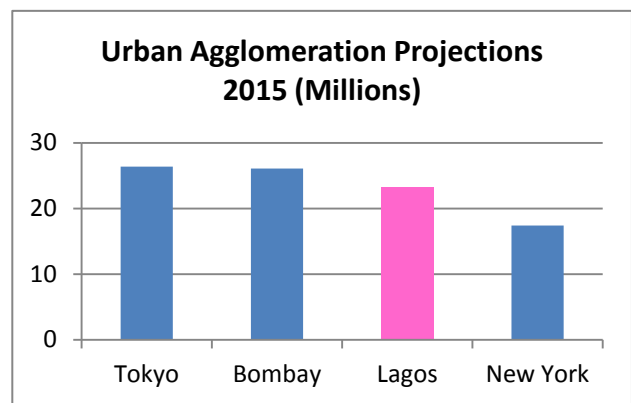




By 2030, there will be more Africans living in cities than the entire Western city population of today.
