

Ethiopia spends a higher proportion of its GDP on university-level education than any OECD country and triple the global average

Between 2003 and 2008, enrollment in African universities grew by 77%, far beyond the global growth rate of 53% for the entire world over the same period.

Ethiopia has made a great progress in supporting university-level education and spends over 6% of its GDP on this, significantly higher than OECD, African and global averages.
