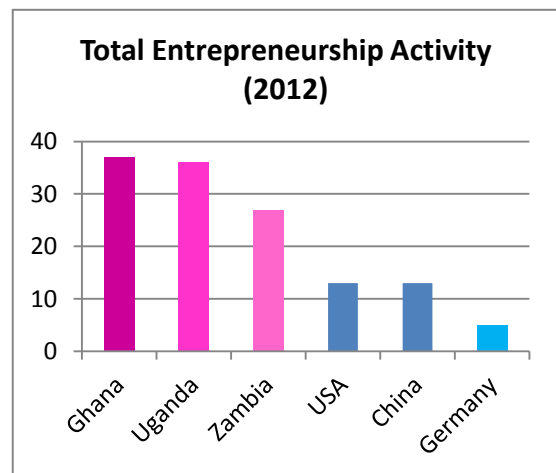




Ghana's rate of early-stage entrepreneurship is the highest in the world and is more than double that of the USA, China and Germany

Ghana leads the world in early-stage dynamic entrepreneurial activity along with other Sub-Saharan African countries including Uganda and Zambia; economic powers such as the USA, China and Germany score much lower on this measure of entrepreneurship.



Innovation Hubs could play an important role in stimulating knowledge-based and technology entrepreneurship in Africa. 2012 saw the number of hubs grow from 29 to 91 across the continent in just one year, with hubs now present in across Africa.
