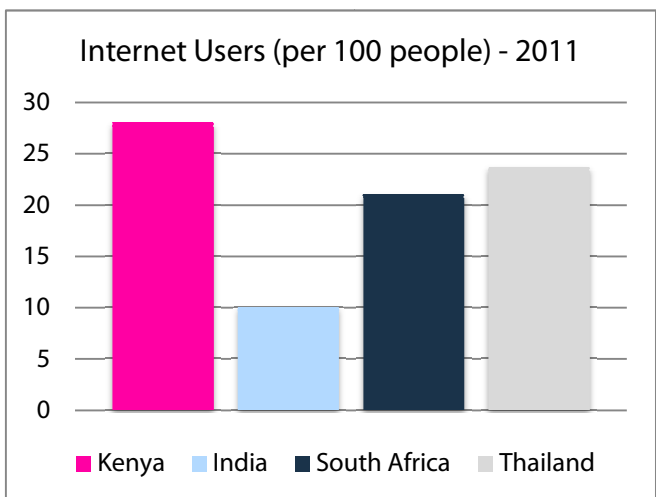




Kenya has more internet users than South Africa and more internet usage than Nigeria

In 2011, Kenya's internet penetration was greater than South Africa's and double that of India's. By 2012, 18 million Kenyans (41% of the population) were using the internet.



Sub-Saharan Africa alone saw a rise of over 400% in internet users in the 2005-2010 period, making this the fastest-growing region in the world; this growth is being led by Kenya and Nigeria.
