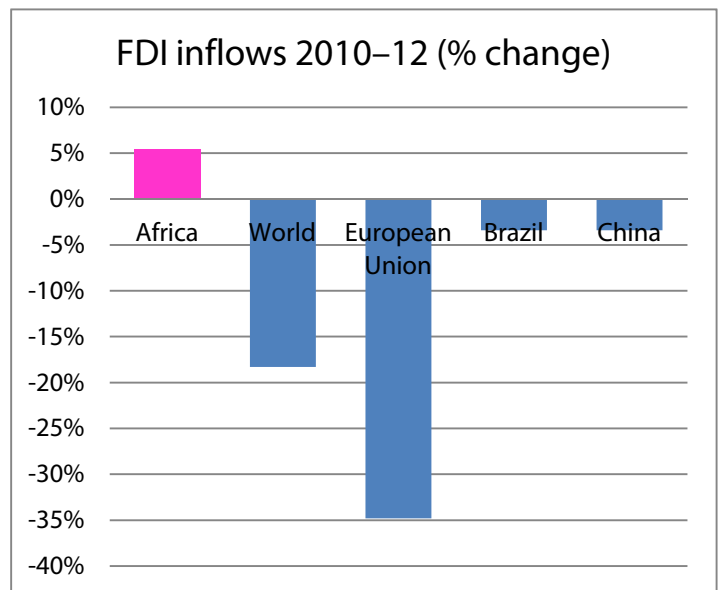




The Fastest-Growing Foreign Direct Investor in Africa is Africa

Against a global backdrop of an 18% drop in Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) from 2010-2012, Africa was the only continent where FDI inflows grew in this period. FDI to Africa is expected to rise again by more than 10% in 2013, driven mainly by service sector investment.



Nigeria and South Africa lead the intra-African FDI inflows to Sub-Saharan Africa. Ghana has been one of the key destinations of intra-African FDI projects, which have grown 50% in the last 5 years.
